

# 10 Days of Word to Thrive

*To encourage all our churches to fast & pray in unity for a move of God to revive us and our churches.*

## DAY 1 - LIKE A THRIVING TREE

Objective: *Set the ground for thriving*

### Psalm 1:3

**3** That person is like a tree planted by streams of water,  
which yields its fruit in season  
and whose leaf does not wither—  
whatever they do prospers.

#### Prayer points:

- Pray that we will capture the value and significance of thriving in God
- Pray that we will desire continual growth in God despite the seasons we may face (Psalm 1:3)

## DAY 2 - BUT FIRST, JESUS

Objective: *Prepare the heart to first desire Jesus before thriving*

### Luke 10:41-42

**41** “Martha, Martha,” the Lord answered, “you are worried and upset about many things, **42** but few things are needed—or indeed only one. [a] Mary has chosen what is better, and it will not be taken away from her.”

#### Prayer points:

- Pray for our heart to solely focus on Jesus (Luke 10:39)
- Pray that we will not get distracted by the business of life (Luke 10:40)
- Pray for help for us to draw near to God and to seek a deeper connection with Jesus (Luke 10:42)

### DAY 3 - THE END GOAL

Objective: *Understand better what thriving is (and what it isn't)*

#### **John 10:10**

The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full.

#### Prayer points:

- Pray that God will reveal His purpose for our lives and renew our sense of calling
- Pray that we will constantly grow toward our end goal, the fullness of life that God has for us (John 10:10b)

### DAY 4: A WAKE UP LETTER

Objective: *Be on guard against spiritual apathy that steals spirit of thriving*

#### **REVELATION 3:15**

*15 I know your deeds, that you are neither cold nor hot. I wish you were either one or the other!*

#### Prayer points:

- Pray that God will reveal to us the things that are stopping us from thriving (Revelation 3:15-17)
- Pray that we will grow in our dependency on God (Revelation 3:18)
- Pray that we will release any burdens at His feet. That there would be an exchange of heaviness with His lightness and ease.

### DAY 5 - BECOMING JOY THRIVERS

Objective: *Grow in thriving attitudes: joy*

#### **1 Peter 1:8**

**8** Though you have not seen him, you love him; and even though you do not see him now, you believe in him and are filled with an inexpressible and glorious joy,

#### Prayer points:

- Pray that God will revive the joy in our hearts (1 Peter 1:8b)
- Pray that God will turn worries, doubts, and anxieties to an inexpressible and glorious joy

## **DAY 6 - BECOMING PRAYER THRIVERS**

Objectives: *Grow in thriving attitudes: prayerful*

### **Ephesians 6:18**

**18** And pray in the Spirit on all occasions with all kinds of prayers and requests. With this in mind, be alert and always keep on praying for all the Lord's people.

#### **Prayer points:**

- Pray that we'll grow in our awareness of God's ever present and active involvement in our lives.
- Pray that we will have an attitude of-surrender to God and will be people who pray unceasingly (Philippians 4:6)

## **DAY 7 - BECOMING THANKFUL THRIVERS**

Objective: *Grow in thriving attitudes: thankfulness*

### **1 Thessalonians 5:18**

**18** give thanks in all circumstances; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus.

#### **Prayer points:**

- Pray that we'll recognise God's grace, goodness and faithfulness even more in our lives.
- Pray that God's Word will deepen our gratitude towards God daily (Colossians 3:16)
- Pray that our thankfulness will be reflected on our speech and conduct (Colossians 3:17)

## **DAY 8 - GROWING IN GRACE AND KNOWLEDGE**

Objective: *Pursue growth in grace and knowledge to thrive*

### **2 Peter 3:18**

**18** But grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. To him be glory both now and forever! Amen.

#### **Prayer points:**

- Pray that God will bring us into a deeper level of understanding and appreciation of His grace
- Pray for a deeper personal knowledge of God, and never-ending desire to know Him more

## **DAY 9 - FRUITFUL**

Objective: *Understand that thriving in God produces fruits*

### **Psalm 92:12-14**

**12** The righteous will flourish like a palm tree,  
they will grow like a cedar of Lebanon;

**13** planted in the house of the LORD,  
they will flourish in the courts of our God.

**14** They will still bear fruit in old age,  
they will stay fresh and green,

### **Prayer points:**

- Pray for a heart that is open and receptive to God's guidance.
- Pray that God will stir the fruits of the Spirit more fully in our life (Galatians 5:22-23)
- Pray that our fruitfulness will bring glory to God and serve as a testimony of His grace and power in our lives.

## **DAY 10 - HIS PRESENCE**

Objective: *Ready our heart to be thirsty and hungry for encountering God*

### **John 15:4-5**

**5** *"I am the vine; you are the branches. If you remain in me and I in you, you will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing.*

### **Prayer points:**

- Pray for God's presence to be poured out in all the sessions.
- Pray for open and receptive hearts for God to renew, restore, and pour out His wisdom, love, and guidance.
- Pray for wisdom and anointing for the speakers, leaders, and everyone involved in the conference.
